Purpose: The Top Awards team lead supports the delivery of quality programmes for young people with a focus on the sectional Top Awards. This includes promoting and recognising Top Awards, and supporting Section leaders to provide pathways for young people to achieve.

Time Commitment: Very flexible, typically 2 hours a week

Terms of Appointment: Role requires a Disclosure check to be completed, and mandatory online training needs to be completed as part of this role within the first few months, which will help you understand your role and the aims of The Scouts.

- To work alongside other key members who support the Explorer Scout and Network sections, including County 14-24 Team Leader and County Young Leaders Team Lead
- Be a role model for all members of Gloucestershire Scouts
